(5) Two, ten-minute sports reviews daily in which Applicant promotes local sporting teams and organization.

(6) Production of a local, thirty-minute, weekly, program discussing farming methods, problems and the like.

(7) Exposition of sub-standard housing problems through in-depth news coverage and news interviews.

(8) News emphases of positive, nonviolent events; five-minute, weekly report of activities that reveal the good news of youth and others — for example, a farm boy's efforts to raise pigs and sell same for a profit, the constructive events of the 4-H, etc.

(9) Carriage of 95% or more of the NBC network documentaries.

(10) Carriage of approximately four and one-half hours per week of religious sermons, sermonettes, stories, events and music.
